ONGOING MAINTENANCE FOR MACHUCA CEMENT TILES

1. Never use acid cleaners for cement tiles. Use only pH neutral mild soap or dish soap.
2. 3M® cloths or similar cleaning tools (such as Scotch Bright® scrubbing pads) are a good choice for tile floors.
3. Many stains can be removed with inexpensive drug store Hydrogen Peroxide. Saturate a clean cloth or white paper towel and let it sit on the stain. It does not harm the tile and is similar to teeth bleaching. You may also apply Clorox, with or without powdered laundry soap, in case the Hydrogen Peroxide was unable to remove the stain. **DO NOT USE MURIATIC ACID.**
4. Mop the tiles with water every day. For added luster, you may start to add wax (Natural Color Wax) when the surface has begun to smoothen.
5. For penetrated stains, you may lightly scrub the tiles using #400 and above sand paper. You may use Clorox afterwards to remove the remaining residue.
